

Small Squares to organize Crochet Projects



How to use the small squares:

- Organize your wool with small crochet squares. Put similar colors on a ring. If you use a little index card with a piece of yarn, brand name and color number, reordering is easy.
- Create an overview of the different colors of a yarn. Combine the colors for a project by placing them next to each other until you like the color combination.
- Save good color combinations by crocheting small keepsakes. Squares in the colors of the completed project.
- Of course you can use the small crochet squares like any other square e.g. as part of bookmarks, placemats or even blankets.

Instructions for the small square

Work into a „magic ring“

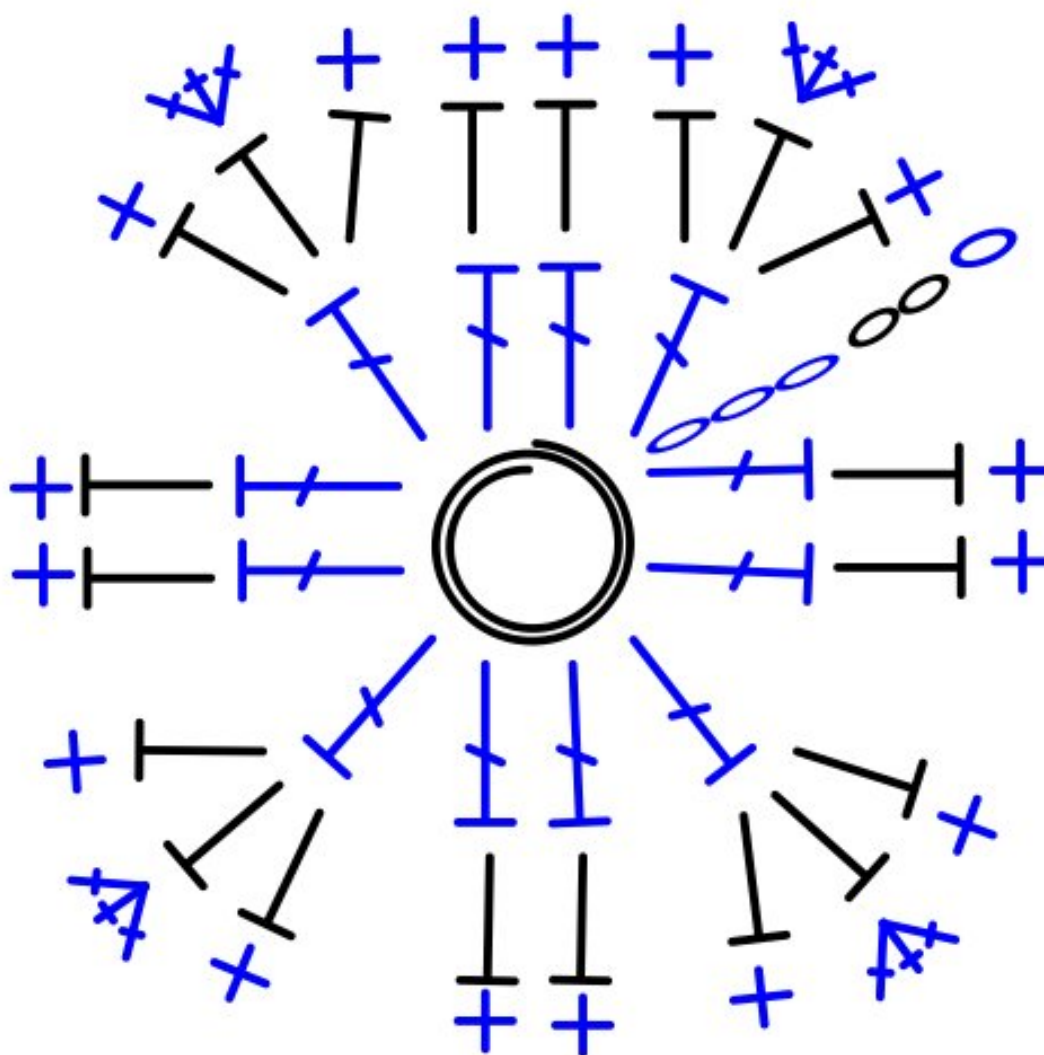
Round 1: Ch 3, 12 dc, ss in das erste dc

Round 2: Ch 2, *(3hdc), 2hdc,* repeat 3 times, ss into the first dc

Round 3: ch, sc, *(3sc), 4sc* repeat 2 times, (3sc), 3sc, ss into the first sc

Finishing: Fasten off and sew in the ends.

Small Square - Crochet Chart



Stitch Key

○	chain stitch (ch)
+	chain stitch (ch)
┆	single crochet (sc)
┆ ┆	half double crochet (hdc)
✕ ↓ ✕	crochet 3 sc into one stitch (3sc)
