

Big Owl Crochet Applique



Instructions:

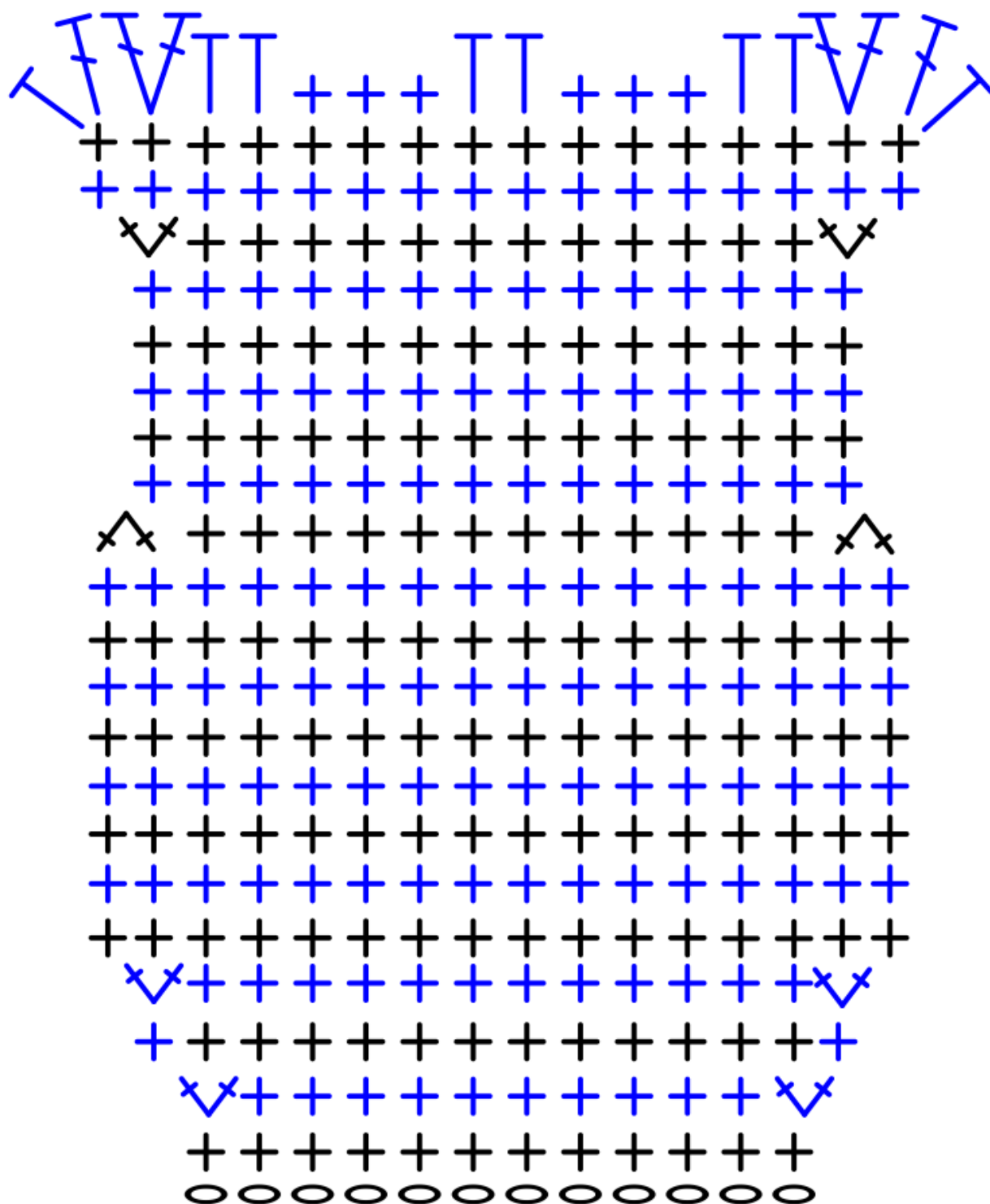
- The Big Owl Crochet Applique consists of different parts, which are sewn together.
Parts: Body, Belly, Wing (crocheted twice), Eye (crocheted twice) and Beak.
- In this pattern you'll find both - a Crochet Chart and a written instruction. It is helpful to look at both to avoid misunderstandings.

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Body - Crochet Chart



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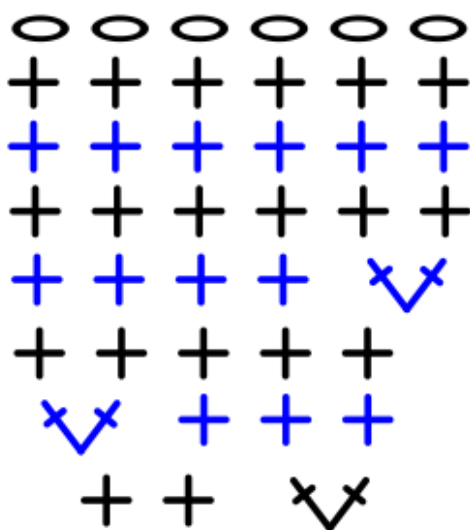


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Instruction for the Body

<i>Beginning:</i>	ch 13	
<i>Row 1:</i>	Start in second ch from hook, 12 sc, ch	12
<i>Row 2:</i>	(2sc), 10 sc, (2sc), ch	14
<i>Row 3:</i>	14 sc, ch	14
<i>Row 4:</i>	(2sc), 12 sc, (2sc), ch	16
<i>Row 5-12:</i>	16 sc, ch	16
<i>Row 13:</i>	2sc2tog, 12 sc, 2sc2tog, ch	14
<i>Row 14- 18:</i>	14 sc, ch	14
<i>Row 19:</i>	(2sc), 12 sc, (2sc), ch	16
<i>Row 20-21:</i>	16 sc, ch 2	16
<i>Row 22:</i> <i>(last Row)</i>	(hdc, dc), (2dc), 2 hdc, 3sc, 2hdc, 3sc, 2hdc, (2dc), (dc, hdc)	20
<i>Finishing:</i>	Fasten off and sew in the ends.	

Belly - Crochet Chart



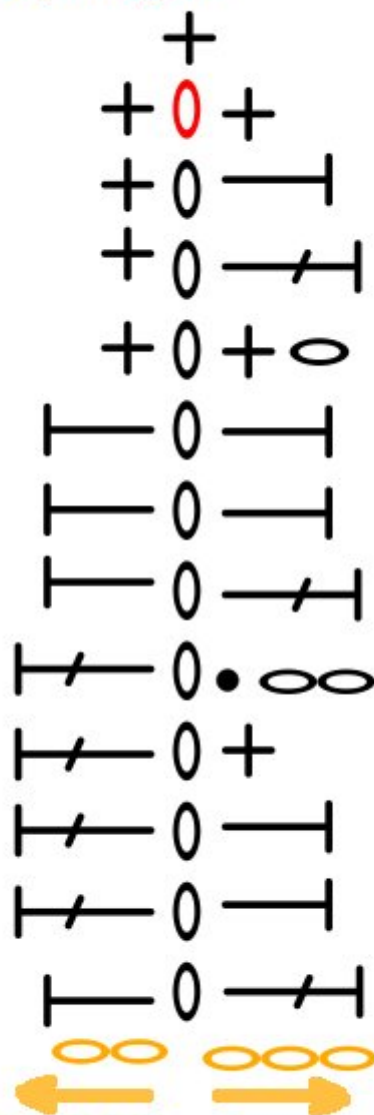
Instruction for the Belly

<i>Beginning:</i>	ch 7	
<i>Row 1-3:</i>	Start in second ch from hook, 6sc, ch	6
<i>Row 4:</i>	2sc2tog, 4sc, ch	5
<i>Row 5:</i>	5sc, ch	5

Row 6:	3sc, 2sc2tog, ch	5
Row 7:	2sc, 2sc2tog	3
Finishing:	Fasten off and sew in the ends.	

Wing - Crochet Chart

Beginning ch



Crochet the wing
twice, once in each
direction.

Instruction for the Wing

crocheted twice

Note: Please look closely at the crochet chart for the wing. To receive two matching wings you have to crochet once in each direction.

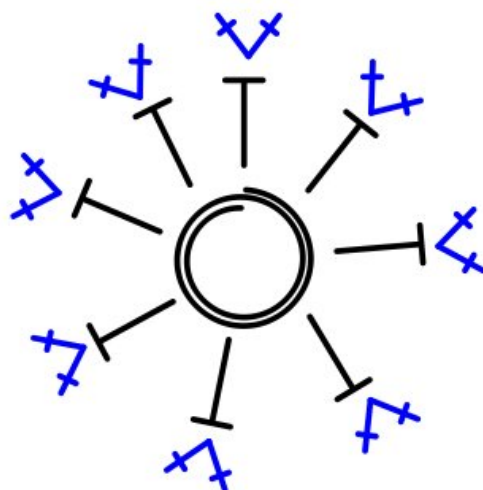
Beginning: ch 12
(both wing)

Right round: ch 3, dc, 2 hdc, sc, (ss, 2 ch), dc, 2hdc, (sc, ch), dc, hdc, (3sc - top end), 3sc, 3hdc, 4dc, hdc, ch 2, ss into the first ch.

Left round: ch 2, hdc, 4dc, 3hdc, 3sc, (3sc - top end), hdc, dc, (ch, sc), 2hdc, dc, (ch 2, ss), sc, 2hdc, dc, ch 3, ss into the first ch.

Finishing: Fasten off and sew in the ends.

Eye - Crochet Chart



Instruction for the Eye - crocheted twice

Work into a „magic ring“

Row 1 2ch, 8hdc, ss into the first hdc, ch

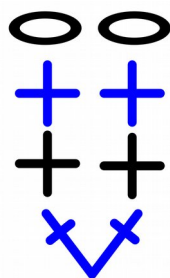

Row 2 (2sc) in every hdc, ss into the first sc

Finishing: Fasten off and sew in the ends.

Beak- Crochet Chart



Instruction for the Beak:

Beginning: ch 3

Row 1: Start in second ch from hook, 2sc, ch 2

Row 2: 2sc, ch 2

Row 3: sc2tog 1

Finishing: Fasten off and sew in the ends.

Completion

- Sew the different parts on the body of the owl. I recommend to secure them first with some pins, this way they don't slip.
- After sewing on the parts there are still two elements missing:

Pupils:

You may use black beads or buttons. But if you intend to use them on kids clothes it is more useful to stitch them. I used a simple French knot. This is more durable (washing machine) and it's not likely to be torn off or being a choking hazard.

Claws:

I used the same color for the claws as for the beak. With three to five simple stitches you can stitch them onto the body. I positioned them as far apart as the ch-row of the belly.

- Embellishments:
It might be nice to embellish the belly with beads or colorful buttons. But I recommend this only if you do not intend to wash it regularly and it's not likely to be torn or being a choking hazard for small children.

Stitch Key

●	single stitch (slip st, ss)
○	chain stitch (ch)
+	single crochet (sc)
∧	crochet 2 sc together - sc2tog
∨	crochet 2 sc into one stitch (2sc)
⊥	half double crochet (hdc)
⊥	double crochet (dc)
∇	crochet 2 dc into one stitch (2dc)



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
